

Klonopin (Clonazepam)

Street Name: Common tranquilizers include: Ativan, Halcion, Rohypnol, Valium, Klonopin, Roofies, Tranks, and Xanax (a particularly fast acting and extremely addicting tranquilizer)

Chemical Name: clonazepam

Routes Of Administration: Oral however, some come in intravenous forms

Effects: Relaxation, drowsiness, sleeps

Risks: One can stop breathing when overdosed with this type of drug. Also abrupt stoppage of this class of drug can in some situations lead to seizures.

Klonopin is particularly useful in the treatment of some seizures. It is also used for treating panic in some patients. FDA approved for atypical absence seizures, akinetic and myoclonic seizures. Also used for patients with panic and/or anxiety disorders.
