Chemical Name: 7,8-Didehydro-4,5-epoxy-17-methylmorphinan-3,6-diol sulfate salt (2:1)
Routes Of Administration: Oral, intravenous (solution), subcutaneous injection (solution).
Effects: Euphoria, drowsiness, constricted pupils, nausea

Risks: This drug is potent. Even small amounts can have grave effects. There is risk of stopping breathing, aspiration and suffocation from inhaling vomit while intoxicated on this drug.

Morphine is derived from the poppy plant. It is readily picked up by a urine test screen.

Morphine is the gold standard to which all opiates are compared. When used as prescribed it helps cancer patients and chronic pain sufferers manage their pain. Morphine comes in intravenous solution as well as in oral tablets.
